One of the oldest cosmetic ingredients in history, it is known as an essential ingredient in Ayurvedic applications for soothing and brightening skin tone. When applied on the skin, the powders feel light, powdery and smooth.

Indian sandalwood heartwood powder has also traditionally been used to create incense sticks, which are burned in rituals and religious practices.

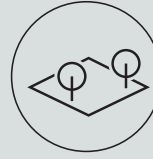

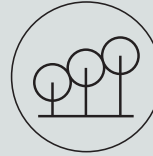
