



If Indian sandalwood is the king of all woods, then Australian sandalwood is the undisputed prince. Whilst retaining the classic woody base note synonymous with sandalwood, Australian sandalwood has a greener, fresher top note than its Indian counterpart. The fragrant aroma of Australian sandalwood oil offers uplifting but calming benefits.

Our Australian sandalwood oil (known as *Santalum spicatum* or *Fusanus spicatus*) is steam distilled at our distillation facility, from small chips of the oil-bearing heartwood, grown in central-Western Australia by the government-regulated Forest Products Commission (FPC). We supply Pure Australian Sandalwood Oil and Pure Australian Sandalwood Oil-Organic Certified, and ensure every step of the process complies with organic standards recognised across the world. Once the trees arrive at our distillation facility, we ensure none of this precious resource is wasted. Every part from the roots to the stems is used to extract the golden, scented oil within.


